The Town of Washington Town Board will have a workshop meeting on Thursday, June 4<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall to discuss the proposed Wetlands Ordinance. Although the Public Hearing remains open on this matter, this meeting is for Board discussion only and public input will not be heard. An additional public hearing will be scheduled for a later date.

The Town of Washington Park is now opened on weekends for picnicking and the enjoyment of the playgrounds and non-swimming activities. The pool will be opened on weekends beginning on June 6<sup>th</sup> from 12 noon – 7:00 PM. The park and pool will be opened daily from June 20<sup>th</sup> – August 23<sup>rd</sup> between the hours of 12 noon and 7:00 PM. Family passes may be purchased during regular park hours at the lifeguard stand. A limited number of non-resident season passes are available for an additional fee. The park is a town owned and operated facility for the enjoyment of our residents. It features swimming, picnic areas, basketball court, ball fields, a sand volley ball court, mini-golf putting green, fishing dock and playground area. Transfer Station Permits for the 2009/10 season are now available at the Town Clerk's office. Permits prices have remained the same at \$75.00 for residents, \$45.00 for seniors and disabled residents or \$355.00 for business permits. Residents wishing to take advantage of the disabled permit fee must present a DDI letter from the Social Security Administration. Permits may be purchased at the Town Hall or through the mail. Checks should be made payable to Town of Washington Town Clerk, P O Box 667, Millbrook, NY 12545. Punch cards remain at 10 bags for \$40. and 5 bags for \$20.00. Please include a copy of your vehicle registration. The Transfer Station is open to residents with permits on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturdays from 7:30 AM – 4:00 PM.
