

Park Groundskeeper Position

Seasonal; Mid- April- Beginning of November; 40 hours a week.

The Town of Washington Park (3744 Route 44 Millbrook, NY) is looking for a self-motivated park service professional to fill a caretaker position. The applicant must be able to work independently and can perform a variety of skilled trade functions using assorted equipment and tools.

Performs the duties below; other duties may be assigned as deemed necessary.

Performs parks maintenance and repair of playground equipment, pavilion and building facilities, drinking fountains and restrooms.

Perform setup for pavilion events, including moving tables and chairs.

Performs routine maintenance of restrooms and trash; picks up and disposes of trash and litter throughout park; empties trash barrels and brings to dump.

Trims and mows grounds. (camp grounds, pool area, and sports fields)

Weeds around bushes and flowers beds.

Trims hedges, sprays and prunes flowers, trees and shrubs.

Operates and performs daily maintenance of assigned equipment used in parks maintenance work, including manual, power and riding mowers, tractors, chainsaws, blowers, truck, weed eaters and edgers, etc.

Maintains park water systems.

Maintains pool filter bed and pool pump and chlorine levels throughout the summer season.

Performs all jobs in a safe and timely manner.

Performs various ad hoc park improvement projects.

Requirements

A minimum of at least (3) years of experience in grounds maintenance and operating mowing equipment.

Ability to work well with public and staff members.

Valid driver's license.

Pass background check and fingerprinting.

Environmental and Physical Requirements:

Physical ability to perform job duties including: walking, bending, climbing ladders and stairs and standing for extended periods of time.

Must regularly lift and/or move at least fifty (50) pounds.
