March 15, 2021

The Town Board of the Town of Washington held a special meeting on Monday, March 15, 2021, beginning at 4:30 PM. Deputy Supervisor Stephen Turletes opened the meeting with the following present: Councilman Robert Audia, Councilman Michael Murphy and Town Clerk Mary Alex. Due to the Coronavirus Pandemic the meeting was held with the Board in person at the Town Hall and via Zoom.

The purpose of the meeting was for the Board to appoint an engineering firm to represent the town on any matters pertaining to Janet's Farm LLC Second Mountain. On a motion made by Councilman Murphy and seconded by Councilman Audia, the Board appointed Rennia Engineering for any Town Board matters requiring review for the review of the Second Mountain petition requesting the Town Board create an overlay district.
